S106 Supported Applications from Duffield Parish Council

MONEY UNDER S106 IS FUNDING THAT IS GIVEN TO THE COMMUNITY BY A DEVELOPER WHEN THEY BUILD HOUSES IN THE AREA. OFTEN THIS MONEY IS USED TO ENHANCE FACILITIES SUCH AS A NEW SCHOOL CLASSROOM OR A NEW PLAYGROUND. IN DUFFIELD, WE ARE A BIT DIFFERENT TO OTHER AREAS, AS ALL THE PUBLIC OPEN SPACES ARE CURRENTLY PROVIDED FOR THE VILLAGE BY THE PARISH COUNCIL. BECAUSE OF THIS WE HAVE WORKED WITH AMBER VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL TO DEVELOP A PROCESS BY WHICH WE CAN ACCESS FUNDS DIRECTLY FOR PROJECTS IN THE VILLAGE. THIS IS CALLED DELEGATED RESPONSIBILITY. THE PARISH COUNCIL ARE THE ONLY BODY THAT HAS THIS POWER AND THIS POWER IS LIMITED TO MAKING RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE ACCESS TO FUNDS EITHER FOR PUBLIC OPEN SPACES OR COMMUNITY FACILITIES. TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL PROJECTS ARE DEVELOPED FOR THE GOOD OF THE COMMUNITY THE PARISH COUNCIL HAS IDENTIFIED CRITERIA THAT IT WILL USE TO ASSESS THE PROJECTS. THE FINAL DECISION ON GRANTING FUNDING REMAINS HOWEVER WITH AMBER VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

WHEN LOOKING AT APPLICATIONS FOR S106 FUNDING THE PARISH COUNCIL WILL LOOK FOR THE CRITERIA AS LISTED BELOW TO BE FULFILLED. IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THERE WILL BE A MUCH GREATER DEMAND THAN FUNDING AVAILABLE, AND EVEN IF ALL THE CRITERIA ARE MATCHED, THE PARISH COUNCIL CANNOT GUARANTEE THAT THE PROJECT WILL BE TAKEN FORWARD. APPLICANTS SHOULD ALSO BE AWARE THAT THE FINAL DECISION IN THE AWARDING OF FUNDING LIES WITH AMBER VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL, AND DUFFIELD PARISH COUNCIL CANNOT GUARANTEE THAT WHERE AN APPLICATION IS SUPPORTED, THAT THE APPLICATIONS WILL BE SUCCESSFUL

CRITERIA THAT THE PARISH COUNCIL WILL USE TO DETERMINE IF SUCH FUNDING APPLICATIONS WILL BE SUPPORTED ARE:

1. THE ORGANISATION OR PROJECT MUST BE DUFFIELD BASED OR CARRY OUT ACTIVITIES (OTHER THAN FUND-RAISING) FOR THE BENEFIT OF DUFFIELD RESIDENTS.
2. THE ORGANISATION OR PROJECT MUST DEMONSTRATE IT BENEFITS THE RESIDENTS OF DUFFIELD.
3. THE ORGANISATION OR PROJECT MUST DEMONSTRATE HOW IT LINKS TO THE OBJECTIVES ON DUFFIELD PARISH COUNCILS PARISH PLAN WHICH CAN BE VIEWED AT WWW.DUFFIELDPC.ORG.UK/ ALTERNATIVELY PLEASE USE THE

CONTACT DETAILS ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THIS GUIDANCE TO OBTAIN A COPY.

4. APPLICATIONS MAY RELATE TO A SCHEME OF CAPITAL COSTS ONLY.
5. APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY AN ORGANISATION NOT CONDUCTED FOR PROFIT
6. APPLICATIONS MUST FALL WITHIN THE FUNDING STREAMS AVAILABLE OPEN SPACE OR COMMUNITY FACILITIES
7. THE ORGANISATION TO WHICH THE APPLICATION RELATES SHOULD NOT BE EXCLUSIVE, BUT SHOULD ALLOW ACCESS TO OR USE/PARTICIPATION BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC. THERE MUST BE NO RESTRICTION ON MEMBERSHIP BY ANY ORGANISATION TO WHICH A GRANT IS TO BE MADE. MEMBERSHIP MUST BE OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND NOT REFUSED ON GROUNDS OF GENDER, RACE, DISABILITY, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, OCCUPATION, RELIGIOUS, POLITICAL OR OTHER BELIEFS.
8. THE PURPOSE TO WHICH THE GRANT IS TO BE APPLIED MUST NOT RELATE TO RELIGIOUS BELIEF OR PARTY POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.
9. APPLICATIONS MUST BE ABLE TO DEMONSTRATE EVIDENCE OF LOCAL SUPPORT AND VOLUNTARY EFFORT.
10. APPLICANTS MUST BE ABLE TO SUBMIT SUCH DETAILS OF SCHEMES AS MAY BE REQUESTED, FOR EXAMPLE PLANS/DIAGRAMS AND RELIABLE COMPETITIVE QUOTATIONS AND DETAILS OF FUNDING PROPOSED.
11. THE APPLICANT MUST PROVE THAT THE NECESSARY PLANNING PERMISSION AND BUILDING CONTROLS HAVE BEEN ACQUIRED FOR ANY BUILDING WORKS WITHIN THE SCHEME.
12. WORKS MUST FALL WITHIN THE CRITERIA SET BY AMBER VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL, AND ALL REQUIREMENTS OF AMBER VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL SHOULD BE MET IN FULL.

*For information 'Open Spaces' constitute playing fields, parks and open spaces protected under policy LC3 of the adopted Amber Valley Borough Local Plan. 'Community Facilities' constitute community centres, village halls, post offices, public houses or other venues that provide a range of activities for local communities and which are protected under policy LC11 of the Local Plan.
