CAR THEFTS ON EYES MEADOW

Following a break in at the Parish Councils sports changing rooms on Eyes Meadow, thieves have made away with two cars and their contents. The Cricket club changing rooms were also broken into but nothing was taken. Police were investigating the break in at the cricket ground when the determined thieves broke in to the Parish Councils' sports changing rooms. Users of changing rooms have again been warned not to leave any items of value in the changing rooms and users of the Meadow are warned that they should not leave items of value in their cars. All cars parked at Eyes Meadow are done so at the owners' risk. If you see anything suspicious please report it immediately to the police on the number provided below, and if the assailants are in a car don't forget to make a note of their number plate.
