Grays Recreational Ground. A request for the balance of funding has been made to Amber Valley Borough Council, and it is hoped that once this has been secured, the installation of the playground will take place. Grant Funding is also being sought from BIFFA an environmental trust. The Parish Council should know about all the funding by December and all being well, the installation of the new playground should start in January. If you would like to have a look at the proposed playground, it is to be displayed at the Parish Office in the Weston Center, so please feel free to pop in and have a look. To ensure a safe play area, members of the Parish Council also resolved that dogs visiting Grays Recreational Ground would no longer be able to run free but must be kept on leads. Notices to this effect will be placed on Gray Recreational Ground. This decision was made possible under the powers awarded to Parish Councils in the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005. Failure to comply can lead to an on the spot fine for offenders.
