### **Apologies for Absence**

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Carmichael-Smith and Knibbs

### **Declaration of Members Interests**

**570**    None were declared

### **Development of Gray Recreational Ground**

Quotations and plans for the development of Grays Recreational Ground having been previously distributed, had been received from Record Limited, Wicksteed Limited and Hags Limited. The quotations included costs for clearance of the existing site, and the supply and installation of the equipment. Councillors viewed the proposal and noted:

Hags Limited: Quotation Price £59, 995. This quotation did not include prices for seats, litter bins, or a junior standard swings. It did include a cost for an Aqito cyclone which was a multi user swing at the cost of £5323.

Record Limited: Quotation Price £60,000. No seesaw was included within the price. Other requirements were met including seats and bins.

Wicksteed: Quotation Price £ 61,800. The fencing on this quotation was 1mtr galvanized rather than 1.2mrt powder coated as required. The Junior play provision on this quotation was inadequate for the size of provision required.

**571**    **Resolved:** that the Clerk seek references and identify sites where each company has installed equipment within the vicinity. The Clerk organise a site visit with

Mr. Simon Gladwin Head of Landscape Service at Amber Valley Borough Council and Committee Members to view these installation.

The option of the installation of a Multi User Games Area (MUGA) was considered by members and it was

- 572 Resolved:** that the installation of a Multi User Games Area (MUGA) would fall in the second phase of the development of the ground however the Clerk should investigate the need for planning permission for this development, and include the installation of a Multi User Games Area (MUGA) in the application process.

The existing entrance sites to Gray Recreational Ground were reviewed. Improved access via a sloped pathway opposite footpath number was considered desirable under the Disability Discrimination Act.

- 573 Resolved:** that quotations be sought for the construction of a new access to Grays Recreational Ground in the form of a sloped path.
